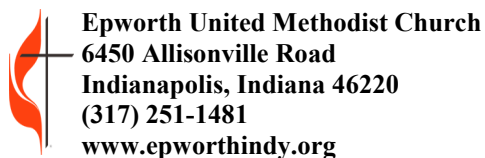

What is the mission of the Church?

How do I join the church?

To be a member of the church, you must have publicly professed your faith and you must have been baptized. You can unite in membership with our church in one of two ways:

1. Confession of Faith.
This is for people who are not a current member of any church.
2. Reaffirmation of Faith
This is for people who are currently a member of another church

Membership in a United Methodist Church involves a commitment to support the church. This support is given in five different areas:



- 1 Prayer
- 2 Attendance
- 3 Financial Giving
- 4 Service
- 5 Witness

We require that you attend a membership inquiry class where you will have the opportunity to learn more about the United Methodist Church.

Church membership is not the culmination of your faith journey. Membership is just one part of a life long pursuit of a life lived in faithful pursuit of Jesus Christ.
