

Finishing the Old Year Strong and Gaining Clarity for 2020

This past Sunday, November 24, we collected the stewardship pledge sheets for the coming year. You still have time to turn in your commitments to the church office. Your pledges help Leadership best plan for the coming year.

Your generosity this year has allowed us to move forward with many of the plans made a year ago, but with adjustments. 2019 has been an eventful year at Epworth. The storm this past Spring meant we spent most of the summer rebuilding our playground and repairing and updating 4 classrooms in our Education wing. Thanks to our insurance, we were able to get all the repairs and updates done with only \$15,000 of extra out of pocket expenses. The Trustees have also been busy with a number of unexpected repairs at the Parsonage. They have continued to work to bring the church HVAC system on-line in order to take advantage of the savings related to better control of the heating and cooling of the building. There is a WISH LIST on this page of more projects that Leadership would like to underwrite to keep the building in good repair for the future.

We share this with you to say continue with your giving as we head to the end of the year and thank you for your pledge of giving for the New Year. We will continue to work hard and prudently as good stewards of your generous gifts.

What's next for Family Ministry?

As we look ahead to 2020, Epworth Leadership remains committed to the importance of ministry to and with our families and their children. Plans and updates were shared with families on Sunday November 17th. Leadership will be putting together a plan for a search for a candidate who will help us build on all the good that is taking place and who will help us continue to build a strong discipleship program for our children, youth, their parents, and young adults.
